

Under Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon

CULTIVAR:

Cabernet Sauvignon (100%)

APPELLATION:

Paarl

IN THE VINEYARDS:

All grapes come from trellised, irrigated vineyards and were hand-picked in the early morning hours between mid-January and late February.

TASTING NOTES:

The superb balance between perfectly ripe hand selected grapes and oak results in a firm structure, rich colour and aroma and a delicate finish. A mouthful of beautiful berry and plum flavours complimented by a hint of dark chocolate from barrel contact.

ANALYSIS:

Alcohol: 14%

Residual sugar: 3.2 g/l

Total Acidity: 5.8 g/l

Volatile Acidity: 0.68 g/l

pH: 3.55

AGEING POTENTIAL:

This wine is drinking beautifully now but will possibly reach it's optimum by winter 2025.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS:

As an all-rounder Cabernet is magnificent with anything from rare to medium-rare grilled steaks, perfectly braised beef dishes or lamb flavoured with a bit of rosemary. For the non meat eaters – grilled portabello mushrooms work a charm as well as hard cheeses such as aged cheddar.
